CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE STAY.

CHECK-IN after 1 PM.

CHECK-OUT TIME is 12 NOON. If you wish to stay longer, check with the office to be sure your space is open for an extension.

RATES: Are based on 2 adults and 2 kids (under 16 years), 1 camping unit, and 1 vehicle per site. Limit 6 people per site unless pre-approved by Management.

VISITORS/GUESTS: A Visitor/Guest is a person not listed on your registration form. Upon arrival, a Visitor/Guest must obtain a Day Pass (\$3 per person) or a Night Pass (\$5 per person) for every day of their stay. Day Pass holders must leave the park before 9:00 PM. Night Pass holders must depart before noon the following day. Visitor's/Guest's vehicles must always display a Car Pass on their mirror and may only park in Visitor Parking. If Visitors/Guests are not registered, a charge of \$5 (for a Day Pass) or \$10 (for a Night Pass) per guest will be charged to your account.

PETS: No designated pet area. Dogs must be on a leash or restrained at all times. Pets are not to be left unattended. Any pet creating a disturbance will be required to leave.

WATER: Vehicle washing is strictly prohibited. Please conserve. \$40 Fine.

TRASH: Please dispose in the Dumpster, located below Cabin #1.

QUIET HOURS: Dark to 8:00 AM. No bright lights please. **SPEED LIMIT: 5 MPH and is strictly enforced.**

CHILDREN: Parents are responsible for their children. No one under the age of 18 is permitted in the park at any time without a responsible adult. No bike riding on lawns, walkways, or through sites. Children are to be on their site after dark. Children under 8 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times.

BBQ GRILLS: Tables must have adequate protection from BBQ/greass.

SMOKING: No smoking in any buildings, including cabins and shelter. Please DO NOT TOSS BUTTS ON GRASS OR GRAVEL.

POOL: Please observe all Rules listed at the pool. Swimmers MUST dry off before going in Restrooms or Store.

THEFT/LOSS: Management is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage to others property after Theft Loss.

FIRE RINGS: Please do not move from spot.

PLEASE DO NOT PARK OR DRIVE ON GRASS. PLEASE DO NOT PLACE RUGS OR MATS ON GRASS.

THIS IS A FAMILY ORIENTED CAMPGROUND. PLEASE help us keep it that way and contact/call us "DAY OR NIGHT" if you hear cursing, frequent dog barking, a party at night, etc. Please call back if no one answers the first time.

Wolfies Campground, its owners and managers, are not responsible for loss or injury from fire, theft, tornados, falling trees, electrical failure, or any act beyond our control – so please be careful. Anyone who absconds, vandalizes, or attempts to defraud the park will be subject to prosecution. Management and owners are not responsible for any injury to persons or pets. All facilities of Wolfies Campground are used by campers and guests at their own risk. The management reserves the right to evict anyone for failing to observe the park rules.
